THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF BANKING AND FINANCE'S CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ISSUED TO JOSE TORRES BECOMES FINAL

Atlanta, Georgia - On November 7, 2006, the Georgia Department of Banking and Finance's ("Department's") Cease and Desist Order issued to loan officer Jose Torres of Duluth, Georgia, became final.

Mr. Torres was issued a Cease and Desist Order by the Department for making misrepresentations in loan files submitted to mortgage lenders.

Pursuant to state law, the Department may revoke the license of a mortgage broker or lender that employs an individual against whom a final Cease and Desist Order has been issued within the preceding three years if the Order resulted from misrepresentations being made in loan applications.
